Hi Talia,

Thanks for speaking with me on the phone earlier. Responses to your questions below-

- We will clean and dismantle our camp site before we leave, removing all equipment, supplies, and wastes (consumable and non-consumable) via helicopter long-lining. We will leave the tundra the way we found it. We will ask to dispose of waste at Eureka Weather Station; if they deny our request, we will take our waste out of Nunavut via chartered flight and dispose of it ourselves.

- The Polar Bear fence will be constructed along with the temporary camp.

- We have sent letters describing our project to Grise Fiord HTO and Resolute Bay HTA. We've been in contact with Terry Noah at Grise Fiord HTO, and Community Liaison Officer Susan Salluviniq at Resolute Bay. Susan expressed no concerns about our project. We are waiting on responses from Resolute Bay HTA and Grise Fiord Community Liaison Officer Inger-Lise Christensen.

- I have reached out to Pierre Fogal at Eureka Weather Station and am awaiting his response.
