RE: DYE-M Laydown area request

Mr. Holwell:

Defence Construction Canada is seeking permission to use the upper site abandoned airstrip at the Cape Dyer (DYE-M) DEW line site for a temporary laydown area for excavated soils. Please note that the airstrip has been out of service for many years, and is no longer believed to be within the boundaries of the DND reserve.

The planned purpose of the laydown area is to temporarily store excavated soils while they're being tested. Upon receiving test results (typically within 10-15 days after transport to the laydown area), the soils are transferred to the applicable engineered landfill on-site. This will be a continual process during the excavation activities at the upper site, and upon completion, the laydown area itself will be tested and any detected contamination will be removed. Note that this process is a normal part of DEW Line remediation activities, with the only difference being the location of this particular laydown area.

This area has been selected due to its level grade, and close proximity to the areas to be remediated. The attached Site Plan shows the location of the abandoned airstrip just north of the property boundary at the upper site (top right of drawing).

We thank you for your assistance on this matter, and look forward to hearing back from you at your earliest convenience. Please feel free to contact me if you require further information.
