Re : Information Required for Forum Uranium Corporation's "North Thelon Joint Venture Right of Way Application" Project Proposal

Dear Jacques Stacey:

On March 5, 2008 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Forum Uranium Corporation's (Forum's) *North Thelon Joint Venture Right of Way* project proposal from the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KivIA). On May 30, 2008, the NIRB received a positive conformity determination (Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan) from the Nunavut Planning Commission, and commenced screening of this file in accordance with Part 4, Section 12 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA). The NIRB assigned this project proposal file number 08EN064.

The application materials provided to the NIRB for Forum's right of way – namely the KivIA application form – listed Peter's Expediting Ltd (PEL) as the contractor responsible for the overland transport of fuel from Baker Lake to cache and drill sites around Forum's property.

In seeking further information regarding the type of equipment to be utilised by PEL, the NIRB was informed on June 2, 2008 that PEL had not been contracted to haul the fuel, instead, Matrix Aviation Solutions Inc (Matrix) was employed to do this work. In addition, Matrix confirmed that fuel was hauled for Forum's exploration program (NIRB file number 07EN046) in the spring of 2008. These overland winter fuel haul activities were previously screened by the NIRB and a screening decision was issued for Matrix's project on April 3, 2008 (NIRB File No. 08FN009).

At this time, the NIRB requests that Forum provide reasoning for its current application for a right of way, considering that the overland transport of fuel for this project has been previously screened and permitted for Matrix Aviation Solutions (08FN009).
