North Thelon Project**

Dear Forum Uranium Corp.:

Thank you for submitting Forum Uranium Corp. 2008 Annual Report for the North Thelon Project to the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) as recommended in the July 11, 2007 Screening Decision Report.

Term and Condition 8 of the Screening Decision Report recommended the following:

8. The Proponent shall submit an annual report with copies provided to the NIRB, INAC, KIA, and the GN-DOE by January 31 each year that the project is in operation commencing January 31, 2008. The report must contain, but not be limited to, the following information:
- a. A summary of activities undertaken for the year;
 - b. A work plan for the following year;
 - c. All monitoring results based on the revised Wildlife Mitigation Plan;
 - d. Description of any wildlife encounters and any actions/mitigation measures taken;
 - e. Evidence regarding the Proponent's commitment to require on-site personnel read and understand the comments provided to NIRB by the GN-DOE, EC and BQCMB;
 - f. A summary of local hires and initiatives;
 - g. A summary of community consultations undertaken as detailed in NIRB application documents (PSIR);
 - h. A summary of site-visits by Land Use Inspectors with results and follow-up actions;
 - i. Any approvals given by Land Use Inspectors regarding Caribou Protection Measures;
 - j. The number of take-offs & landings from an airstrip with approved flight path with date and location;

- k. The number of helicopter touch-downs on the land with date and location (provided unless confidential);
- l. Site photos;
- m. Progressive reclamation work undertaken;
- n. Efforts made to achieve compliance with the Canadian Wide Standards for Dioxins and Furans, and the Canadian Wide Standards for Mercury;
- o. The results of compliance with above noted standards when proposed incinerator is applied to dispose of used oil proposed by the Proponent;
- p. A summary of the number and location of spills and failures which activated the Spill Contingency Plan; and
- q. A summary of how the Proponent has complied with NIRB conditions contained within this Screening Decision, and the conditions associated with all authorizations for project proposal.

Upon review of your submission, the following deficiencies have been identified:

- e. Evidence regarding the Proponent's commitment to require on-site personnel read and understand the comments provided to NIRB by the GN-DOE, EC and BQCMB; **this information was not provided.**
- j. The number of take-offs & landings from an airstrip with approved flight path with date and location; **please provide a hard copy of the digital files already submitted (this information will be kept confidential upon request)**
- k. The number of helicopter touch-downs on the land with date and location; **please provide a hard copy of the digital files already submitted (this information will be kept confidential upon request)**

This information was *not* included in the 2008 Annual Report as outlined in the Screening Decision Report from July 11, 2007. As a result, the NIRB is requesting submission of this information by April 3, 2009.
