Modifications and Extensions of N2011C0033 and N2012C0005

Dear Tracey,

MMG would like to notify the AANDC of its intention to complete reclamation work on crown land associated with both its High Lake and Izok projects during the 2015 field season with the intention of closing out these permits. For this purpose, MMG would like to extend the active LUP's for its High Lake and Izok Projects.

There are no further exploration activities planned for either of these projects and surface diamond drilling and its associated activities can be removed from the scope of work contemplated by the permits. The coming field season will concentrate on the dismantling and removal of structures, demobilization of equipment, removal of materials and waste, and general reclamation.

We would ask that the expiry date of said permits be extended for a period of one year, (from January 29, 2015 to January 29, 2016 in the case of High Lake, and from February 28th, 2015 to February 28th, 2016 in the case of Izok), with the goal of coordinating with AANDC to complete close out inspections at some point during this field season.
