NON-TECHNICAL PROJECT PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION

In June 2014, Aura Silver signed an option agreement with Agnico Eagle to recommence drilling at its Greyhound Property. This option agreement will allow Agnico Eagle to earn interest in the Project. The Greyhound property is located 40-50 km northwest of the Hamlet of Baker Lake and is transected by the Meadowbank access road.

This request is to renew or replace the Land Use Permit #N2010C0008 that was granted by AANDC and that will expire by May 2015. This land use permit authorizes mineral exploration in this area. The principal work will be diamond drilling, but prospecting and geophysical surveying could also be performed. The workers and staff associated to the exploration on the Greyhound property will be based at the Meadowbank mine and the transport will mainly be by helicopter during the summer period. No field camp will be set up.

All activities proposed for this program are considered grassroots or early stage exploration activities. No economic precious metals have yet been found but surface indications are very encouraging. A total in excess of \$ USA 6.6 million has been spend on exploration activities by Aura Silver.

All work will be performed by Agnico Eagle crews and drilling contractors; all of whom are highly experienced in working in the Arctic. Aura Silver completed an archeological survey in the area of exploration and all historical archeological sites have been recorded. This work was completed by Barad Novecosky, a Senior Archaeologist for Golder Associates Ltd.

About Aura Silver

Aura Silver Resources Inc. is a junior explorer searching for precious metals in Nunavut. The Company is listed on the Venture Exchange as AUU:TSX. Aura Silver's Nunavut Certificate of Registration of an Extra-Territorial Corporation is (ET8722) and it's prospecting licence no. is N33560.

About Agnico Eagle

Agnico Eagle has operated the 100% owned Meadowbank open-pit gold mine located about 110 kilometres by road north of the Hamlet of Baker Lake, the nearest community since 2010. Meadowbank depends on the annual, warm-weather sealift by barge from Hudson Bay to Baker Lake for transportation of bulk supplies and heavy equipment. An all-weather road links Baker Lake to the site.

An on-site airstrip is used for shipping food and goods and for transporting employees, who work on a fly-in, fly-out basis.
