Greyhound Property Exploration Project: Annual Report on Wildlife Monitoring

Monitoring and reporting requirements

“The Proponent shall maintain a record of wildlife observations while operating within the project area. The reports should include locations (i.e., latitude and longitude), species, number of animals, a description of the animal activity, and a description of the gender and age of animals if possible. Prior to conducting project activities, the Proponent should map the location of any sensitive wildlife sites such as denning sites, calving areas, caribou crossing sites, and raptor nests in the project area, and identify the timing of critical life history events (i.e., calving, mating, denning and nesting). Additionally, the Proponent should indicate potential impacts from the project, and ensure that operational activities are managed and modified to avoid impacts on wildlife and sensitive sites.”

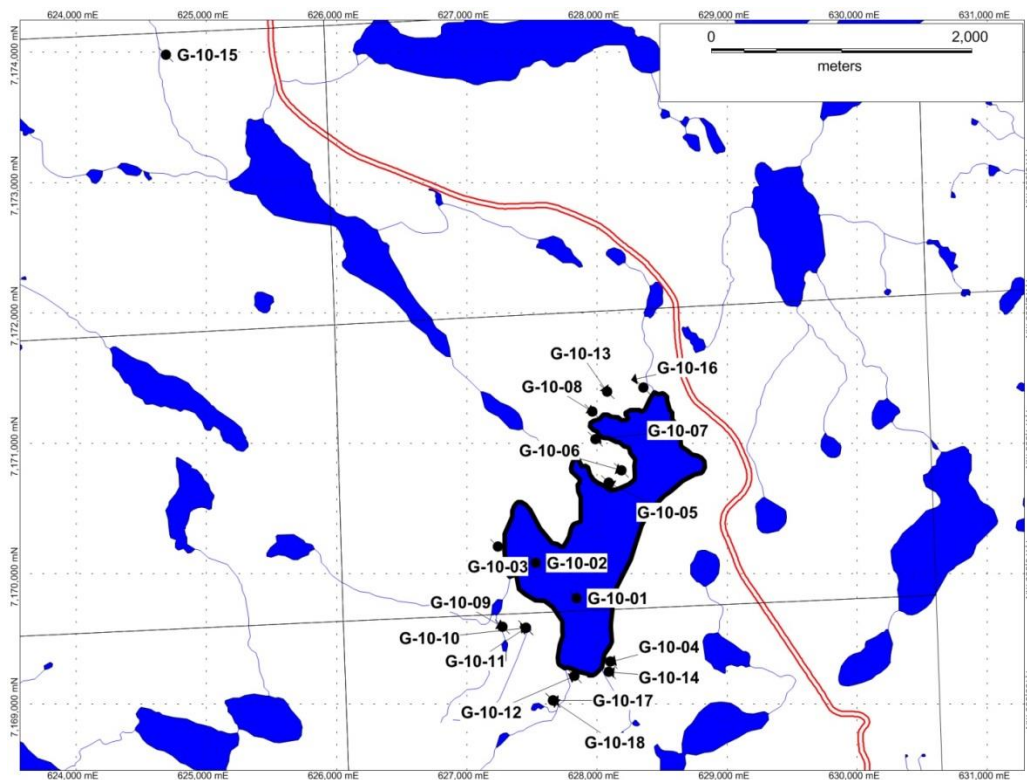

Please find below a brief wildlife monitoring summary report for 2010 activities on claims in the Baker Lake area.

BACKGROUND AND PROJECT DESCRIPTION

In the summer of 2010 Aura Silver conducted a drilling and surface sampling program across 10 wholly owned claims in the Baker Lake District. This work was filed as an assessment report dated Sept. 25th, 2011 reporting on the results of 2,000m of diamond drilling from June 2 to-Oct. 14, 2010.

The following map pinpoints the drilling activity locations:



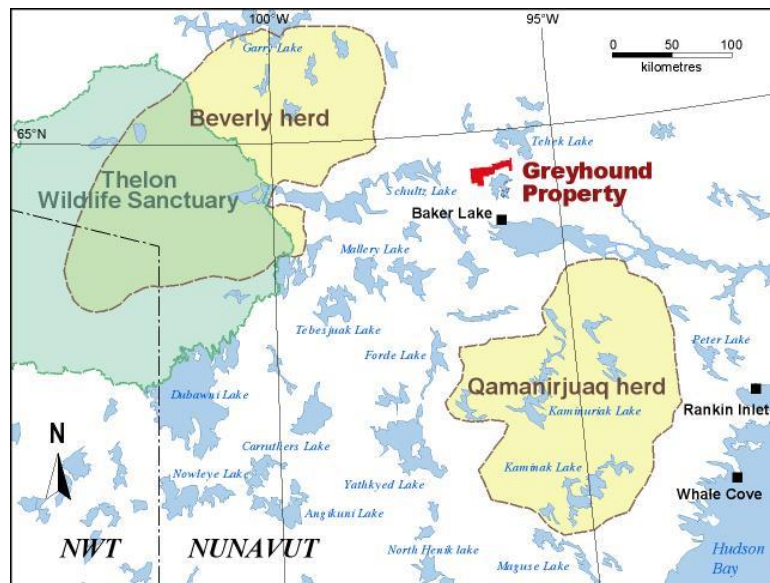

NOTES ON WILDLIFE ACTIVITY

The attached map illustrates that the proposed work area lie outside of any sensitive, designated environmental, recreational or migratory routes.



During the period of activity the drilling crews did not report any spotting of wildlife. During crew changes and placement of the drills the helicopter pilot did not report any caribou sighting from the air.
