Introduction

In June 2014, Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd (Agnico Eagle) signed an option agreement with Aura Silver Resources Inc. to recommence drilling on the Greyhound Property. This option agreement allowed Agnico Eagle to gain interest in the Project following exploration activities and for which Agnico Eagle is the project operator. The Greyhound property is located 40-50 km northwest of the Hamlet of Baker Lake and is transected by the Meadowbank mine All Weather Access Road.

Monitoring and reporting requirements

The Proponent shall maintain a record of wildlife observations while operating within the project area. The reports should include locations (i.e., latitude and longitude), species, number of animals, a description of the animal activity, and a description of the gender and age of animals if possible.

No wildlife was noted during the short exploration activity period in the area covered by this decision.

Work performed

9 holes were drilled in 2021 in the area covered by this decision and mineral prospecting was done on foot along with helicopter support. The drilling site location is shown on Figure 1.

Work Planned 2022




Figure 2, 2022 Drilling Locations Proposal

In 2022, mineral prospecting and geophysical surveys are planned to be conducted on the property and 5 holes are planned to be drilled at locations shown on Figure 2. Equipment, material and workers will be transported by helicopter from the Meadowbank Mine Site to the exploration areas. No exploration camp or fuel cache is planned to be installed in the area covered by this screening decision.
