Dear Mr. Kavanagh:

Biogénie was granted the above-mentioned Land Use Permit to transport and store equipment between Dewar Lakes and Kangok Fjord, Nunavut.

Most of the equipment (90%) was demobilized from Dewar Lakes to Kangok Fjord in the winter of 2012 and removed by sealift in September 2013. Remaining equipment includes 6 Challenger tractors, sleighs, a school bus, a pick-up truck, a bulldozer, a fuel tank and a survival camp.

This permit expires on March 12, 2014. Due to poor ice conditions in April 2013 which prevented us from transporting the equipment to the beachhead at Kangok Fjord where the sealift can reach it, Biogénie was forced to abandon and postpone operations. We are thus requesting an extension to the current permit to allow us enough time to move the equipment.
