Land Use Permit #N2011X0030**

Dear Ms. Pugh:

Biogenie was granted the above-mentioned Land Use Permit to transport and store equipment between Dewar Lakes and Kangok Fjord, Nunavut.

Most of the equipment (90%) was demobilized from Dewar Lakes to Kangok Fjord in the winter of 2012 and removed by sealift in September 2013. Another portion was removed in September 2014. The remaining equipment on the Kangok Fjord beach head (NWS beachhead) consists of 4 Challenger tractors, 4 sleighs and 1 empty fuel tank. The purpose of the storage of this equipment is to transport five new (and empty) 90,000-litre fuel storage tanks via cat-train to Dewar Lakes from Kangok Fjord for the North Warning System at Dewar Lakes. This is the only possible mode of transportation for this size of tank. The contract was awarded to us by Nasittuq Corporation but because the contract wasn't completed before Raytheon Canada Ltd. took over NWS operations, we are currently awaiting a revised contract to complete the work. The current permit expires on March 12, 2015. We are thus requesting an extension to allow us enough time to move the storage tanks to Dewar Lakes.
