Dear Carl Perkins:

Please be advised that Section 12.7.1 (b) of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA) states:

*"a recommendation of Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) pursuant to a 12.4.4 (a) may provide for the establishment of a monitoring program for that project which may specify responsibilities for the proponent, NIRB or Government."*

Further, Section 12.7.3 (a) of the NLCA states:

Without limiting the generality of Section 12.7.2, the monitoring program set up pursuant to that section may include:

*"a requirement that regulatory agencies and the proponent supply NIRB with reports and information respecting project operations and impacts, and the implementation of mitigative measures."*

According to the terms and conditions contained in the NIRB's Screening Decision Report on August 27, 2013 for the "Nueltin Lake" project proposal, URU Metals Ltd. is to submit an Annual Report to the NIRB no later than March 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. At this time, the NIRB has not yet received URU Metals Ltd.'s annual report for the "Nueltin Lake" project proposal for the 2013 reporting period.

URU is advised to refer to the terms and conditions issued within the Screening Decision Report attached regarding the submission of your Annual Report. NIRB is requesting this information by **November 6, 2014**.
