TITLE: Monitoring the Ice Edge Break up in Eclipse Sound.

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:

The purpose of this project is to monitor and characterize the landfast ice sheet covering Eclipse Sound before, during and after its break up in late spring and early summer, by way of two autonomous time lapse camera systems deployed on high lands on both sides of the eastern end of Eclipse Sound. Each system consists in an insulated box containing the camera and hardware powered by onbe battery and one solar panel. The equipment will be brought on sites by snowmobiles for installation in May, and by boat for recovery at the end of summer, with the help of hunters from Pond Inlet. Results will be shared with project partners and the community through the Ocean's North website.


