21. Additional Information (Attach additional pages if necessary.)

Each drilling site uses an area of less than 400m² which includes the drill and the support equipment. The time spent at a drilling site is generally short, only a couple days. When the drilling is completed, the casing is removed or cut at ground level and the site is cleaned from remaining waste.

This permit is required for many years to cover exploration works on a wide area. We estimate the total area covered for the next 3 years to less than 4 hectares. This area will be adjust over the time according to needs.
