## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR GOVERNMENT ACCESS**

**PERSONS EXERCISING A RIGHT OF GOVERNMENT ACCESS UNDER ARTICLE 21, PART 5 OF THE NUNAVUT FINAL AGREEMENT (except for access under 2. 21.5.11) ARE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:**

- No mischief (s. 21.5.4)
- Persons exercising right will be liable for damages caused to lands (s.21.5.4)
- Persons who fail to comply with the conditions of Article 21 will be deemed to be trespassers and may be removed from the land (s. 21.5.4)
- Where more than insignificant damage may be caused or where there may be more than insignificant interference with Inuit use and quiet enjoyment of land, Government shall consult with the Regional Inuit Association and seek its agreement regarding procedures for exercising access other than access for activities in Schedule 21-4 (s. 21.5.5)
- Access by government personnel for purpose of wildlife management and research subject to approval of NWMB after consulting with RWO (s. 21.5.7)
- Access by DND for maneuvers other than those pursuant to s.257 of National Defence Act subject to prior negotiation and conclusion of agreement with DIO regarding contact persons, consultation mechanisms and timing thereof and compensation for damages (s.21.5.12)
- Reasonable advance notice, in Inuktitut, of military maneuvers shall be given by DND to the inhabitants of any area affected (s. 21.5.13)
- If continuing use or occupancy for more than 2 years is required, the Regional Inuit Association may require Government to obtain an interest in the land (s. 21.5.2)
