Hi Sophia,

For my current research activities, we stay at two main field locations:

1. Expedition Fiord, Axel Heiberg Island (79 25.98N, 90 45.96W): at this site we stay at the McGill Arctic Research Station, which has been running since the 1950s and consists of approximately 6 wooden huts and Weatherhaven tents. We're typically at this location for ~2-6 weeks/yr. More information about the station is at:

2. Purple Valley, Northern Ellesmere Island (82 28.983N, 80 59.983W): we set up a temporary camp at this location each time that we visit, with typically 4 tents (3 personal, 1 kitchen). We're typically at this location for ~2 weeks/yr, and use it to access the Northern Ellesmere Icefield and associated ice shelves.

Attached is a document with the maps of each of the ice caps where I'm proposing to do research, including zoom-ins of the two camp locations that I mention above.
