Re: Termination of Assessment Activities for Hamlet of Naujaat’s “Water Licence Amendment” Project Proposal

Dear Megan Lusty,

On June 7, 2016 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received the Hamlet of Naujaat’s (the Hamlet) “Water Licence Amendment” project proposal from the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC or Commission). The NIRB assigned this project proposal file number 16UN038.

After several inquiries regarding the application, on July 14, 2016 the NIRB requested formal clarification from the NPC regarding whether the Hamlet’s application with the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) had satisfied the definition of “project” required by the Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NuPPAA). On August 18, 2016 the NIRB and NWB received notice from the NPC that screening by the NIRB was not required and it was instead forwarding the application to the NWB for consideration. As a result, the Board is hereby terminating any related assessment or consideration of the application.
