I just looked at the comments on my application, and I only saw a comment by DFO and nothing by INAC in the comment section.

In terms of the DFO comment regarding the disturbance of marine mammals:

We will make sure that we survey the area for marine mammals to avoid disturbing them. If marine mammals are encountered, and remain in the area, we will avoid disturbing them by rerouting, slowly navigating around their location at a reduced speed and maintaining their distance. We will not accelerate within 400m of the marine mammals or approach marine mammals closer than 100m..
