## PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Former Iqaluit Metal Dump Remediation” project is located within the Qikiqtani region, approximately 1.7 kilometres (km) southwest of the City of Iqaluit and adjacent to the Sylvia Grinnell Territorial Park. The Proponent intends to conduct remedial activities at the project site to improve environmental conditions of the site and enhance the quality of the downstream surface water environment. The project is proposed to take place from May to December 2017 with monitoring until December 2020. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of an access road
- Removal of contaminated soil and sediment
- Capping, contouring, and revegetation of the site
- Removal of debris and landfill
