Subject: Re: 17EN059: Opportunity to address comments (Additional Comments from Government of Nunavut)

This change in the number of comments received 6 days after the initial letter dated July 26 means that we have 8 days over a holiday weekend and not the two week period that you refer to in your email. Due to the number and nature of the comments from the Government of Nunavut, we will require more time to properly respond. We have been informed that there will be an NRC-organized meeting on caribou issues in Winnipeg on the August 14/15th. The key purpose of the session is to help define the approach to managing with the 'caribou issue' specifically as it relates to the Grays Bay Road and Port Project. However, given the increasingly overlap of all these issues, this meeting could also provide an opportunity to consider the CO-31 exploration application with the possibility of generating some advice for our benefit.

We would like to extend the deadline to August 18, 2017 to allow for the results of this meeting to be properly included in our response to the NIRB
