**RE: NPC File No. 151031 Huckleberry Claims**

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. **Primary land use:** Mineral exploration.
2. **Project description:** Advanced mineral exploration activities.
  - a. Diamond drilling and magnetic gradiometry.
3. **Summary of modifications:**
  - a. Bulk sampling up to 500 tons using jaw crusher and hammer mill with small sluice box capable of doing 1 ton per hour; water usage is estimated at 35 cubic meters per day for up to 25 days.
4. **Personnel & Project schedule:** 4 persons & 40 days (160 person-days) between 11 July and 19 September 2026
5. **Associated NPC File Nos.:** 148281 and 148647; **Associated NIRB File Nos.:** 16EN035 (Huckleberry Claim) and 17EA068 (Huckleberry Claim)
6. **Location:** Kivalliq Administrative Region (Keewatin Planning Region); Huckleberry-001 mineral claim at Fat Lake, approximately 65 km west of the Hamlet of Whale Cove
