RE: NPC File No: 150171 [Iqaluit Power Plant Filter]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Addition of water treatment system to improve the water quality of the existing Iqaluit Power Plant Basement Sump. The existing system have revealed contamination of various type. The Project consist of building a sorbent-type filtration system in order to ensure that all the water that discharged into the Iqaluit municipal sewer is as clean as possible.
2. Modifications to the original/amended project proposal: Addition of a sorbent-type filter system with VIPOR units.
3. Related NPC File No: 148652; Related NIRB File No: 17XN070
4. Location: Qikiqtani Region [Iqaluit, Within municipal boundaries]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The NPC previously reviewed works and activities associated with the current project proposal including the construction of an additional fuel tank storage and replacement farm liner in the existing berm area, and a determination was issued on December 11, 2017 (NPC file 148652) that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.

In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB File No: 17XN070).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that the inclusion of VIPOR units to improve performance of the power plant's basement sump filtration system does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials are available at the following address:
