The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Scientific Research: The overall goals of the research include sampling soils to measure the amount of carbon stored, relate the soil carbon storage to the types of vegetation present, map the spatial area of vegetation types, measure potential environmental controls that might be affecting the area of peat patches, including air and soil temperatures, soil moisture, and topography. The fields works involve: Collection of soil cores, mapping of surface topography and vegetation, mapping of surface topography and vegetation, and imaging surface vegetation.
2. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [South Baffin, within and near the communities of Iqaluit, Kimmirut, Cape Dorset, and Pangnirtung].
