The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Modification to change the dates of the project: start date 2022-07-01 instead of 2021-07-05, and end date 2022-09-15 instead of 2021-09-15.
  - a. Project activities remain the same: *To survey Northern Fulmar (NOFU) nesting colonies in the Lancaster Sound region, at Prince Leopold Island (PLI), Cape Liddon (Devon Island), Hobhouse Inlet (Devon Island), Cape Vera (Devon Island), Baillarge Bay (Baffin Island), and Princess Charlotte Monument.*
2. Related NPC FILE No: 148645, 148757, 148765; 149078, 149284, 149488; Associated NIRB File Nos: 06YN015 and 06YN024
3. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [Lancaster Sound region, at Prince Leopold Island (PLI), Cape Liddon (Devon Island), Hobhouse Inlet (Devon Island), Cape Vera (Devon Island), Baillarge Bay (Baffin Island), and Princess Charlotte Monument.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has completed its review of the above noted project proposal. The activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC (File No. 149488), and a conformity determination was issued on August 11, 2021, which still applies. In addition, the activities were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 06YN015 and 06YN024). The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that it does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials, including the applicable conformity requirements, are available at the following address:
