Dear Kelli Gillard,

On October 18, 2021, Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) completed the review of the Clyde River Small Craft Harbour Development project and issued a Screening Decision Report (SDR) to Fisheries and Oceans Canada - Small Craft Harbours (DFO-SCH).

Included in the scope of this review was the construction and use of a construction camp by the contractor to support project activities. The intent was to close and remove the temporary camp at the end of construction in 2025. DFO-SCH was recently informed that Pilitak (the contractor) obtained a lease from the Municipality of Clyde River to keep the camp location for 30 years. The construction camp is on municipal property and the Municipality of Clyde River has provided their approval for Pilitak to keep the camp in the community.

The contractor's long-term activities are unrelated to the Clyde River Harbour Development Project, and are outside of DFO-SCH's operational control. As such, DFO-SCH will not be not associated with any future use of the construction camp site after the Harbour Development Project is completed.
