

The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to the project because it includes the construction of a new sewage lagoon and the modification of effluent parameters.

The project proposal requires screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) because the new activities do not belong to a class of exempt works or activities set out in Schedule 12-1 of the Nunavut Agreement.
