The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Municipal marine infrastructure: Test pits are to understand ground conditions within the Kinngait foreshore to support detailed design of the Kinngait marine infrastructure. Test pits will consist of beach excavation, which will occur in out-ofwater tidal conditions in the Kinngait Study Area. Up to nine test pits will be dug and will be approximately 1 m x 3 m and 4 m deep.
2. Location: Qikiqtani Region; [Coast of Kinngait]
