Re: Additional Information Required: Information Request # 2 for Pulaarvik Kablu Friendship Centre's "Access Trail to Campsite" Project Proposal

Dear Charlotte Zawadski:

On November 23, 2022 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received a referral to screen Pulaarvik Kablu Friendship Centre's "Access Trail to Campsite" project proposal from the Nunavut Planning Commission (Commission), with an accompanying positive conformity determination with the Keewatin Regional Land Use Plan.

On November 23, 2022 the NIRB requested that the Proponent complete the online application form through the NIRB's public registry system and ensure, pursuant to s. 144(1) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, S.C. 2013, c. 14, s. 2 (*NuPPAA*), that sufficient information is provided to determine the scope of the project activities being proposed and to commence screening.

Following a preliminary completeness check of the proposal as submitted, the NIRB determined that the proposal did not contain the necessary information for the NIRB to carry out its screening and on October 27, 2023 requested that the Proponent provide the Board with the requested information in order to carry out the screening of the project proposal. The NIRB followed up via email (November 7, 2023) requesting an update on when the additional information would be provided. To date, the Board has not received the requested information or notification regarding when the information would be made available. Please note that if the Proponent fails to submit the requested additional information, the Board may suspend the assessment activities of the proposed project pursuant to s. 144(2) of the *NuPPAA*. Therefore, it is in Pulaarvik Kablu Friendship Centre's best interest to cure the identified information deficiencies in a timely manner.

The NIRB is again requesting submission of the information as enclosed and for the information to be provided by **November 16, 2023**. If Pulaarvik Kablu Friendship Centre determines that the

time required to supply the required information is significantly greater than one (1) week, the Board requests written notification and an anticipated date for submission be provided as soon as possible.
