PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Ocean Nova 2023 – Arctic Cruises” project is located within the Qikiqtani (North and South Baffin) region, within the Northwest Passage, stopping in Pond Inlet, Iqaluit, and Qikiqtarjuaq. The Proponent intends to conduct tourism activities involving wildlife sightseeing, zodiac cruises and visits to communities. The program is proposed to take place September 2023. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of up to 8 zodiacs to facilitate shore landings and sightseeing excursions;
- Storage and use of fuel for vessel and zodiac operations;
- Generation of combustible wastes, and non-combustible wastes with disposal/recycling at a certified reception port; and
- Generation of sewage and grey water with treatment on board, disposal as per Canadian legislation.
