PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Chesterfield Inlet Sealift Facility improvements Project, NU” project is located within the Kivalliq region, within the municipal boundaries of the community of Chesterfield Inlet. The Proponent intends to conduct a field and laboratory program consisting of subsurface investigations for the future development of an expanded sealift laydown area for the community. The program is proposed to take place from September 2023 to October 2024. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of a backhoe to excavate and backfill up to six (6) holes in the beach at low tide;
- Collection of marine sediment samples for laboratory testing;
- Use of fuel for backhoe;
- Use of local equipment and operator for the life of the project;
