## PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “CD-Wastewater Treatment Plant” project is located within the Qikiqtani region, in the community of Kinngait. The Proponent intends to construct a new mechanical wastewater treatment plant (WWTP), replacing the existing wastewater treatment system. The program is proposed to take place from Period of construction: May 2025 to December 2027; Period of Operations: January 2028 to December 2045. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construct a new wastewater treatment plant (WWTP),
- Use of 10,000 litres of diesel to resupply equipment, concrete mixers and portable power supply generators;
- Use of 647 kilograms of alum polymer annually;
- Use of the plant for a lifespan of 20 years.
