The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. RENEWAL of Type B water license for municipal operations.
  - a. No significant modifications to the municipal water supply and treatment of water, or changes to solid waste are requested with regards to the location, type of land use, or timing of the work from the previous application.
  - b. Furthermore, no changes to water withdrawal volumes are requested.
2. Project Schedule:

The NPC has completed its review of the above-noted project proposal and has determined that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The works and activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC on 1 April 2016, including water supply and treatment, and solid waste management.

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) because it belongs to a class of exempt works or activities set out in Schedule 12-1 of the *Nunavut Agreement*, and the NPC does not have concerns regarding the cumulative impacts of the project proposal.
