The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. AMENDMENT to Type B Water Licence for municipal wastewater treatment plant.
2. Summary of proposed modification:

A complete description of the project proposal reviewed by the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) can be accessed online using the link below.

The NPC has completed its review of the above-noted project proposal and has determined that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. Works and activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC on 28 December 2023. In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB File No. 24WA002).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that the addition of an emergency sewage lagoon does not change the general scope of the original project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the *Nunavut Agreement* do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials are available at the following address:
