The NIRB has determined that the FEIS Addendum conforms with the relevant requirements of the Environmental Impact Statement Guidelines (IS Guidelines) for the Mary River and SOP2 applicable to the Board's assessment of the Project Proposal, and the minimum IS requirements as set out under Section 12.5.2 of the *Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada (Nunavut Agreement)*, s. 101(3) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, S.C. 2013, c. 14, s. 2 (*NuPPAA*), and the NIRB's additional direction to the level which would enable the assessment to proceed.
