Re: Notice of Request to Suspend NIRB Review of the Sustaining Operations Proposal 2

Dear Madam Chair and Minister Vandal,

Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation (**Baffinland**) is writing to inform the Nunavut Impact Review Board (**NIRB**) and Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (**CIRNAC**) that it is requesting a suspension of the NIRB's review of the Sustaining Operations Proposal 2 (**SOP2**), in accordance with Section 143 of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* (**NuPPAA**).

Baffinland will advise the NIRB in due course when it wishes to resume the SOP2 review and anticipates that at that time, the NIRB will issue an updated process map which provides for the outstanding procedural steps (i.e., response to Baffinland information requests, technical comments, technical meeting, community roundtable(s), final written submissions, public hearing).
