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<p>Do you have any suggestions or recommendations for this application?</p> <p>Transport Canada (TC) does not approve construction plans but is responsible for reviewing them for aviation impacts. TC will determine if an obstacle needs to be marked and/or lit. An Airport Zoning Regulations (AZR) assessment may also preclude building if an obstruction is assessed to be unsafe.</p> <p>The Kugaaruk Diesel Power Plant proposal is located within the Obstacle Limitation Surface – Transitional Surface, which is also a part of the Kugaaruk AZR.</p> <p>TC requires an Aeronautical Assessment Form to be submitted for the planned construction, along with a legal land survey as the construction falls within AZR. This information can be submitted to PNR Aeronautical Assessment: aviation.pnraaf-rpnfea@tc.gc.ca. Per the NIRB application, this process is already underway.</p>
