**RE: NPC File # 150444 [Sealift laydown Area]**

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. The proponent is proposing the construction of a new sealift laydown yard, boat ramp, pushout, new access road, and signage adjacent to the existing tank farm.
  - The new pushout/breakwater will allow accessibility for fuel deliveries in the future if the existing dock is no longer safe to access.
  - It will also allow the community to attach a floating dock for small craft before the sealift ships arrive.
2. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [Cambridge Bay].
