I think the money could help with Food security and housing in Nunavut instead of building a road. They're are many Inuit who live in over crowded homes and would live to have their own home. There is also many of us who live up north who have to pay very expensive for basic groceries.

Please consider not going through with this project as it will damage the environment and the damage the communities.
