PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Arviat New Quarry Sites” project is located within the Kivalliq region, within the Municipal boundaries of Arviat. The Proponent intends to construct new quarry sites. The proposed new quarry/aggregate sites will serve current and future aggregate needs of the Hamlet of Arviat, such as road construction and maintenance, land grading/scraping and other similar hamlet needs. The program is proposed to take place from July 2024 to September 2024. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of a CAT loader to excavate quarry material
- Use of a Dump truck to haul quarry material
- Use of a Track excavator to excavate quarry material
- Use of a Screener to screen undesirable aggregate and large boulders
