The proposed “Hydrology Modelling for McKeand River South” project is located within the Qikiqtani region, approximately 60 kilometres (km) from Iqaluit. The Proponent intends to collect river current data at McKeand River South. The program is proposed to take place from 2024 to 2025. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Placement of two (2) Autosalt water flow monitoring systems
- Use of a helicopter based in Iqaluit for transport to place and remove equipment
