RE: NPC File # 150553 [Taloyoak Sealift Improvement]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. The proponent is proposing a sealift improvement project that consist of the construction of a 50m by 120m aggregate pad to support the sealift material delivery. The project would be constructed into Stanners Harbour, using locally available aggregates. The volume of material required will be determined following the Bathymetric Survey and the elevation of the new sealift area will match adjacent roadways.
2. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [Taloyoak].

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.
