RE: NPC File No. 150567 [Kugaaruk Barge Landing Expansion Project]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. The Hamlet of Kugaaruk is planning to expand the size of the existing barge landing area and associated sealift cargo storage area and access road to meet the growing re-supply needs of the Hamlet.
 - a. Blasting, excavation, and placement of aggregate
 - b. Widening of access road and slope improvements
 - c. Potential installation of signage, fencing, and security office
2. Timing, Duration, & Personnel:
 - a. 120 days over period 1 June 202 to 31 October 2025
 - b. 10 personnel for a total of 1200 person-days
3. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [Hamlet of Kugaaruk]

The NPC has completed its review of the above-noted project proposal and has determined that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The project proposal requires screening by the Nunavut Impact Review Board
