As hunters, we rely on boats to harvest food that sustains our families and supports our community and culture. We understand that mitigation measures will be implemented to minimize any potential impacts on wildlife and to confirm that our access to water and ice are maintained at all times while the harbour is being constructed. We do not have any concerns about the Project impacting wildlife, fish or fish habitat or our ability to harvest.

We look forward to continued collaboration with the Project team and to the construction of this important harbour for our community.
