To Whom It May Concern:

The Hamlet of Grise Fiord is supportive of the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) Screening Application submitted by Worley on behalf of the Government of Nunavut for our Community Harbour (the Project).

The Hamlet has collaborated closely with the Project team over the past several years on the Project design and construction planning.

The Hamlet has the capacity to provide municipal services to the Project (in particular potable and non-potable water and solid waste disposal). During the construction phase, we expect the Project team to work closely with the Hamlet and the Government of Nunavut's Community and Government Services (CGS) to assess and manage wastewater needs. We understand, should the sewage lagoon prove insufficient, that the contractor will implement appropriate measures to address the temporary increase in wastewater, without compromising the community's infrastructure.

We understand that the Project is coordinating with the Government of Nunavut's Petroleum Products Division to confirm that the fuel needs for the Project will be met without burdening the community's already strained fuel supply. We are also aware that due to limited accommodations in the community, a camp for approximately 30 workers will likely be required. We are supportive of a construction camp and will work directly with the selected contractor to locate an appropriate area for the camp within our municipal boundaries.

The Project has the Hamlet's approval to operate and source rock from a new quarry that will be located up the valley located to the north-west of the community including stockpile areas located east of the airport runway. We are also supportive of the Project building a road and making improvements to our existing hamlet road (the haul route) to haul rock from the new quarry to the community harbour site.

We look forward to our long awaited and much needed harbour and the many benefits this Project will bring to our community.
