This letter is to inform you that the Resolute Bay Hunters and Trappers' Association (HTA) is in full support of the Community Harbour Project for Resolute Bay.

The HTA board of directors has been consulted on the design and construction planning for the harbour on several occasions over the last 6 years.

A harbour is critical infrastructure needed for the safety and efficiency of boating and is currently lacking in our community. Considering that we, as hunters, rely on boating to feed our families and support our community, the construction of a community harbour is a welcome development.

We understand that mitigation measures will be implemented to minimize any potential impacts on wildlife and to confirm that our access to water and ice are maintained at all times while the harbour is being constructed. We do not have any concerns about the Project impacting wildlife, fish or fish habitat or our ability to harvest.

We look forward to continued collaboration with the Project team and to the construction of this important harbour for our community.
