RE: NPC File No. 150661 [Monitoring Program Pilot in Ahiak MBS]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Scientific research related to wildlife: The Ahiak Area Co-Management Committee (ACMC), responsible for managing the Ahiak Migratory Bird Sanctuary (MBS), will develop and implement monitoring protocols for priority species which include species at risk, light geese, and other birds.
 - a. Arctic PRISM (Program for Regional and International Shorebird Monitoring) monitors shorebirds and other non-colonially nesting birds to find out which bird species are there, if they are breeding or not, how many there are, and what habitats they are using.
2. Timing, Duration, & Personnel:
 - a. 21 days over period 1 March 2025 to 31 July 2027
 - i. 2025: Project development
 - ii. 2026: Fuel caching in March/April, field work in June, fuel drum cleanup
 - iii. 2027: Project wrap-up including removing any remaining fuel drums

- b. 6 personnel for a total of 126 person-days
- 3. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [Ahiak Migratory Bird Sanctuary: Elice River, Perry River, Karrak Lake, and McNaughton Lake]
