RE: Wildlife Observation Licence

Dear Mr. Gillies,

This letter constitutes a **Wildlife Observation Licence**, issued under the authority of *Section 37(1)* of the *Licences and Tags Regulations* under the *Wildlife Act (Nunavut)*. This licence is issued to **Eagle-Eye Tours** and will remain in effect for the duration of your activities near Cambridge Bay, Nunavut, between May 1 and July 31, 2025.

This document fulfills the requirement for a licence for you and your staff, and any other individuals you employ for the duration of your project. The requirement for this licence is found under *Section 117(2)* under the *Wildlife Act (Nunavut)* where it states:

“No person shall, without a licence authorizing it, establish, offer or provide any organized activity in which wildlife is the object of interaction, manipulation or close observation, including the making of a film or the provision of an expedition, safari or cruise.”

In the event that a Conservation Officer in the community, or any other designated authority restricts your action or activity in any way, you are to comply immediately without delay.

The total cost of this licence is \$183.75, to be paid in full at the nearest Wildlife Office.
