## PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Wildlife Tours - 2025 Nunavut Trips” project is located within the Kitikmeot and Qikiqtani regions, near the communities of Pond Inlet, Sanirajak and Cambridge Bay. The Proponent intends to conduct educational tourism activities near Pond Inlet, Sanirajak (Hall Beach) and Cambridge Bay to observe wildlife and birds. The program is proposed to take place from May 24 to July 6, 2025. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Transport guests to floe-edge by snowmobiles and komatik sleds to observe wildlife
- Transport guests daily by car or van to various birding locations
- Hiring of local guides where possible
- Transport guest by boat to observe marine wildlife
