Reference: MMG Izok Corridor Project Mineral Exploration – Opportunity to Address Comments – Government of Nunavut

MMG would like to express our appreciation to all the regulatory agencies for their comments and proposed recommendations. Further, MMG would like to also acknowledge the Government of Nunavut's (GN) comments provided to the NIRB on July 15th, 2025, which were inadvertently missed during the initial comment response provided by MMG. Similar to the July 22nd, 2025 submission, MMG offers the following responses to the comments and recommendations provided by the Government of Nunavut:

Comment and Recommendation Overview

- Contents of Wildlife Management Plan related to caribou protection measures
- Recommendation to update Wildlife Management Plan to be consistent with other materials submitted, specify thresholds that would trigger suspension of operations, address vulnerabilities of caribou during different seasons, align with current caribou protection measures utilized by operating projects in Nunavut, and address caribou herding procedures

Response

MMG appreciates the importance of management and contingency plans and commits to a careful review and update of the Wildlife Management Plan to reflect current conditions for caribou herds, updated scientific information and wildlife mitigation measures, including addressing seasonal stages of caribou vulnerability, and identifying thresholds for suspension of operations. MMG has begun engagement with GNWT-ECC to establish an Information Release Agreement that facilitates access to GPS caribou collar maps and will incorporate this information into exploration program planning. MMG is also working on aligning with current caribou protection measures utilized in Nunavut, by other operators, which are acceptable to the GN.
