To whom it may concern:

Qulliq Energy Corporation (QEC) is engaged in efforts to enable the transition away from diesel generation and incorporate renewable generation into the electricity system. QEC is currently offering the Net Metering Program and the Commercial and Institutional Power Producer (CIPP) Program, as well as the anticipated Independent Power Producer (IPP) Program.

QEC is aware of Nunasi Corporation's plan to develop, build, and operate a new 1000 kW solar and 1000 kW/675 kWh energy storage system in Cambridge Bay and that they are applying for federal funding under the Clean Energy for Rural and Remote Communities program for this project.

QEC is supportive of Nunasi Corporation's new clean energy project, and once funding is secured, expects the corporation to follow QEC's formal IPP application process for their project, including the Connection Impact Assessment study, before moving on with the procurement and installation of the system equipment. The project is an excellent example how stakeholders can lead in the transition away from diesel fuel. QEC hopeful to work with proponents to enable leadership on clean energy to be successful.
