PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Cambridge Bay Solar + Storage” project is located within the Kitikmeot region, approximately 50 kilometres (km) from Cambridge Bay. The Proponent intends to conduct, build, and operate a 3000 kilowatt (kW) solar and battery energy storage system in Cambridge Bay that would be connected under Qulliq Energy Corporation’s Independent Power Producer program. The program is proposed to take place from June 2026 to October 2058. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of flatbed trucks with a telescopic crane to transport equipment to the project site;
- Use of a diesel generator for on-site power needs during construction;
- Use of a pile driver to install the piles;
- Daily transport of personnel to the project site by pickup trucks
